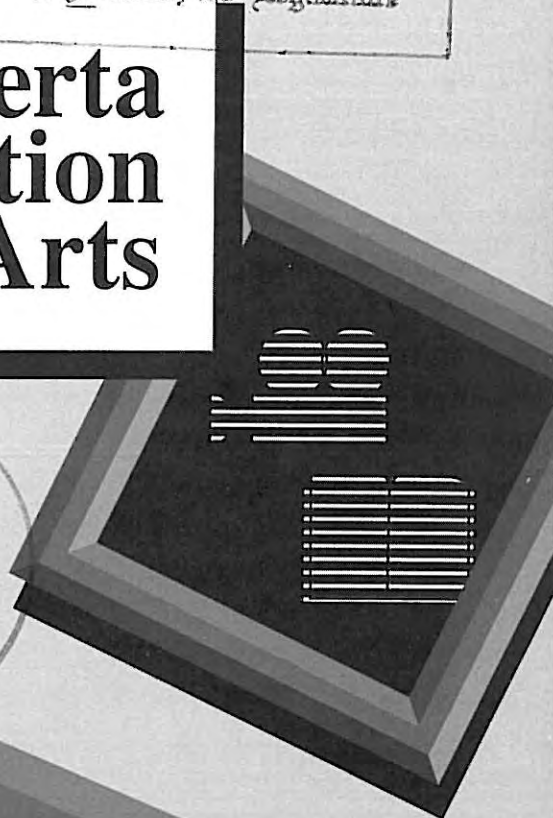
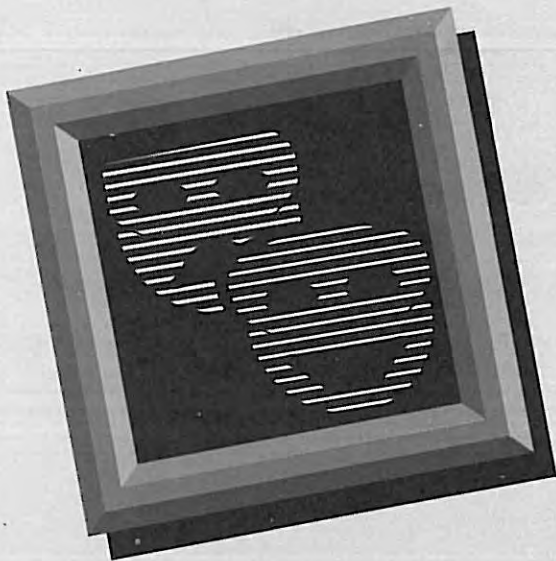

It is a pleasure, Minister, to present the Alberta Foundation for the Arts Annual Report for 1993/94.

During the year, the Foundation continued to analyze the data and information collected from 'Let's Talk Culture', a series of regional meetings with the artistic communities in the province. The assistance of Alberta Community Development, Arts and Cultural Industries Branch was instrumental in identifying the needs and concerns of the communities, some of which were addressed through the development and implementation of new programs or the expansion of existing programs. The Rural Alberta Project, for example, was developed to encourage and assist rural communities to share cultural resources. The Artists in Schools Residency program was expanded to include the visual, literary and media arts. A new component for art purchase was added to the Art Commission Program, which now makes matching grants available to public institutes and non-profit organizations.

At the same time that a number of new or expanded programs were being launched, others were being combined and streamlined for effective administration and the convenience of applicants. The approximately 120 grant programs operated by the three cultural Foundations that preceded the Alberta Foundation for the Arts have now been reduced to 70.

The bulk of the Foundation's budget (approximately 91%) is devoted to our basic activity, the pro-

vision of grants. As the principal public funding source in Alberta, the Foundation acts as the Government's agent to assist with the cultural development of the province. We do this by providing financial assistance to artists and arts organizations, in turn making it possible for the artistic talents of the people of Alberta to be developed. In part because of the Foundation's support, Alberta audiences have an opportunity to see, hear and read a wide variety of cultural and artistic performances and products, from both Alberta and outside sources.

It is, of course, the generous allocation of resources from the Lottery Fund which make this financial assistance possible. I believe our grants, in general, present one of the very best and most productive uses of lottery funding authorized by the Government of Alberta. The majority of the Foundation's grants can be conveniently categorized as either operating assistance or project support.

Operating assistance payments in 1993/94 amounted to just over \$13 million. They ranged from \$5,000 or less to smaller organizations like the Lethbridge Community Band Society and the Handweavers, Spinners and Dyers of Alberta to over \$1 million to major facilities like the Calgary Centre for Performing Arts and Edmonton's Citadel Theatre. The Foundation provided operating assistance to a variety of organizations including libraries, music festivals, orchestras, publishing companies, trade associations and provincial arts service organizations. Our grants normally amount to less than twenty percent of the budget of an organization, but can be critical in enabling the organization to carry out its mandate and attract other funding.

Project support amounted to \$2.4 million in 1993/94. Funding ranged from a grant of \$112 to a Calgary visual artist to a grant of \$21,000 to a senior writer, and from \$300 to the Association Canadienne-française pour l'avancement des Sciences to \$19,300 to the Alberta Ballet Company. Project grants can be awarded for purposes as varied as the study of Highland dance, an international tour by a rock band, a market survey for a periodical, or the production of an experimental film. As with operational assistance, these grants serve as catalysts which enable projects to go forward. They are typically only a fraction of the total support required to carry out projects, but it is usually a crucial fraction.

The Art Acquisition Program is one of our basic activities. We purchase the work of contemporary Alberta artists, partly in lieu of a more expensive program of grants, and we maintain and exhibit that work. As a result, the Foundation collection - more than 4800 works - represents the work of almost every significant visual artist in Alberta. The quality of the collection and the reputation of the Foundation have also resulted in very substantial donations of art, chiefly by Alberta artists. In 1993/94, the Foundation's collection was enriched to an extraordinary degree this way. We accepted large representative donations of the work of Graham Peacock, of Edmonton, and of Ron (now R. Gyo-Zo) Spickett, of Calgary.

Artworks are purchased directly by the board, through regional acquisition committees, and by an annual, province-wide juried selection based on the submission of slides.

There are two important sub-programs: Art Loan, which provides exposure of the Foundation collection through display in public buildings, such as ministers' offices and the Legislature, or the premises of non-profit organizations, and through loan to galleries for exhibitions in and outside Alberta; and Art Promotion. The latter has produced three series of videos entitled "Investing in Art", two of which have been widely broadcast in Canada and the USA. We expect the third, just finished, will be equally popular. Each series focuses on six Alberta visual artists, exploring their art and their approaches to making art. The video footage and the interviews with these senior Alberta artists also have very significant historic values.

As of March 31, 1994, the Foundation comprised ten members, as opposed to the original twelve appointed in September, 1991. The terms of our Vice-Chairman (and former Chairman of the Alberta Foundation for the Literary Arts) Harold Jepson, Thomas Peacocke, formerly of the Alberta Foundation for the Performing Arts, and James Freeman, previously a member of the Alberta Art Foundation, were completed. Their experience, initiative, and wise counsel will be hard to replace. Bonnie Laycock, another former Alberta Art Foundation member and the member who has co-ordinated the regional art acquisition activity of the board, was reappointed. We

welcome a new member, as well, Malcolm Edwards, of Calgary, a past president of the Alberta Choral Federation.

The Foundation continues to be grateful for the help provided by your department. We depend especially on assistance from the Arts and Cultural Industries Branch and the Libraries Branch. On a personal note, I was disappointed by the decision to end the arrangement which saw the former Assistant Deputy Minister of Culture and Multiculturalism, Glen Buick, serve as our first Secretary and Executive Director. The entire board of the Foundation shared that disappointment. I know Glen played a major role in planning, designing and implementing the legislation for the Foundation. I do not think it is too much to say that he deserves credit for a great deal of the success we have had carrying out this enormous institutional change, with the very substantial administrative savings realized. Glen's dedication to the arts in Alberta, his ability to make sensible decisions and to offer wise counsel to the Board and the Government, will be sorely missed, as will his cooperative spirit and his good humor.

I would also like to thank the staff of the Foundation for a job well done. Though few in number, they have been diligently delivering Foundation programs and services to the public and Government. Last but not least, I sincerely thank my colleagues on the Board for their dedication to the business of the Foundation, and for their constant and unfailing moral support of me.

Please accept my sincere thanks to the Government for the allocation of resources from the Lottery Fund, and our appreciation of the news that this support will be continued into 1997.

The arts organizations, artists, cultural industries, and libraries of Alberta continued to benefit from the programs of the Foundation throughout 1993/94, with grants totalling \$16 million-odd being approved by the Board at the same time as it continued its review of policies and programs. That review produced a number of changes, while maintaining the base of familiar programs and continuing with the Foundation's commitment to seeking the advice of members of the community in making grants, through the jury process.

Ninety-two individuals, most of them practising artists, arts administrators or teachers in Alberta, served on juries through the year, making recommendations on the awarding of most of the individual grants of the Foundation, and providing comments and advice on the programs to the Board. Grant applicants benefit from having their applications considered by experts in the field, and this continuing contact with a wide range of members of Alberta's arts community is an important asset for the Foundation. The Foundation encourages the nomination of qualified persons to act as jurors - information and nomination forms are available from the Foundation office or from Alberta Community Development. Normally a person serves as a juror once during a year. The Foundation's policy is to ensure that there is at least a 1-year period before serving again.

The Foundation's art collection is acquired mainly through direct purchase by regional acquisition committees of the Board. A jury of experts is involved in one of the most important elements of the process - the annual art acquisition through slide submission. This year, the jury chose 43 works (by 42 artists) from the 1,207 slides they reviewed. Twenty-two of these artists were newcomers to the Foundation collection. The process is one which helps new artists gain recognition through becoming part of a major collection.

The collection of the Alberta Foundation for the Arts has become one of the province's most significant cultural assets. It now includes over 4,800 works of art, with a total value of more than \$5 million. The collection's reputation, and the practices established through its inception by the Alberta Art Foun-

ation, have made it very attractive to donors, as well as to the artists and galleries of the province. Among the donations this year was a significant collection of paintings by one of Alberta's seminal artists and teachers, Ron Spickett (R. Gyo-Zo Spickett).

Making sure these works of art are not only conserved properly, but can be seen by the people of Alberta, is one of the principle goals of the Foundation. While budget considerations make it impossible to organize regular exhibits, the Foundation sponsors an important, province-wide travelling exhibition program run by four Alberta public galleries, co-ordinated by the Edmonton Art Gallery. As a result, thousands of Albertans see original works of art in their communities, which otherwise would rarely be able to host such exhibits. Artworks from the Foundation collection, along with pieces from other public and private collections, receive much exposure through this touring program. Works from the collection were also exhibited this year in public galleries in Calgary, Edmonton, Grande Prairie, Lethbridge, Medicine Hat and also in Toronto.

The Foundation has been asked to review its visual arts policies, and to consider whether the collecting and exhibiting activities should be continued.

The Foundation's ongoing review of its grant policies affected many of the largest grant categories during the year. Significant changes were proposed to the funding of Provincial Arts Service Organizations (PASOs) and, after numerous meetings with staff and board members of several PASOs, a new, more equitable policy was established. The new policy puts a ceiling on grants to these organizations, while protecting them through gradual changes to grant allocations, and sets clear guidelines for funding both to those in the category and to new applicants.

Consultations were conducted with representatives of public art galleries and with major and smaller professional performing arts organizations to explore the advantages of changing grant policies affecting them. It was agreed to simplify the


system for art galleries, and to leave present policies for major and smaller professional performing arts companies in place until further review is completed.

The transfer of responsibility for “multicultural” arts funding to the Foundation had begun some years ago with a pilot program in the performing arts, affecting the Amateur Operating Assistance Program. Support by both the Foundation and the Multiculturalism Commission had been consolidated in one program but funded separately. 1993/94 saw the culmination of this process, with the Foundation becoming solely responsible for all arts support programs. \$350,000 was transferred from the Commission’s lottery allocation to enable the change to be completed by the Foundation without adversely affecting other programs.

This year the Foundation in partnership with CKUA Radio presented the work of Alberta poets to a wider audience. “Poets’ Quarter”, hosted by Mary Howes, appeared for 10 weeks as part of Arts Alberta, CKUA’s weekly arts magazine program.

This has been my final year as an Alberta public servant, and as the first Secretary and Executive Director of the Alberta Foundation for the Arts. I leave with some regret at not being able to continue to influence the course of the Foundation’s development, but with a great sense of pride in the work that we have done. We have operated efficiently, even frugally, but have contributed in an important way to the ability of Alberta’s artists and arts organizations to flourish. There are a great many people whom I want to acknowledge personally: first, the artists whose work makes ours worthwhile, and the producers, administrators and volunteers without whom Alberta’s arts sector could not function; the staff of the Foundation, for their knowledge, expertise, support, and hard work: Tin Ng, Rona Landry, Marie Achtymichuk, Gail Lint, Bruce Wright, Hal Wong, Lori Bidniak, Clive Padfield, and the staff of the Arts and Cultural Industries Branch, unhappily too many to list here, whose devotion and expertise are a wonderful cultural resource of this province; the Board Members who built the Foundation well: Harold Jepson, Jack Goth, Linda

Cameron, Pat Cavill, Sheila Edwards, Jim Freeman, Olive Green, Bonnie Laycock, Lucille Partington, Tom Peacocke, Bill Preshing, Dale Simmons, Carol Watamaniuk, Doug Wright; and the Foundation’s Chairman, Dick Jarvis, who has been a devoted and effective champion of the arts in Alberta, a leader and conciliator of extraordinary talent, and a good friend. ## Art Acquisition

The Foundation continued with its art acquisition program which is part of its mandate as outlined in the Alberta Foundation for the Arts Act. This program reflects the commitment of the Government of Alberta in support of the visual arts, and provides public recognition of the excellence of Alberta artists.

The policy of this program regarding an artist's residency, was modified in early 1994. The Foundation will only purchase an artwork if the artist is an Alberta resident who has lived and practised art independently in Alberta for at least one year immediately prior to the proposed acquisition. (A "resident" means a person lawfully entitled to be or to remain in Canada, whose primary residence is in Alberta, and who ordinarily lives in Alberta.)

Ms. Bonnie Laycock continued to coordinate the Foundation's Regional Acquisition Committees, and the annual juried Art Acquisition Through Slide Submission Project. In 1993/94 a total of \$271,665 was disbursed for the purchase of 168 artworks, created by 151 Alberta artists (Appendix I). At March 31, 1994, the collection consisted of 4,861 pieces of art, with a market value of \$5,338,459. Some 1,300 artists, who have produced works in the categories of painting, drawing, sculpture, printmaking, ceramic, fibre, photography and mixed media, are represented in the collection.

## *Art Exposure*

To complement its art acquisition activities, the Foundation further promotes and encourages Alberta's visual artists through its exposure program. Works are made available to a wide and varied audience through Foundation exhibitions, a Foundation sponsored travelling exhibition program and an art loan program for a provincial, national and international client base.

### **Exhibitions**

Exhibitions which exclusively featured Foundation works were:

#### ***Recapitulation: A Journey***

Sponsored by the Istituto Italiano di Cultura, this exhibition featured 29 large scale watercolours. The works were selected from a series that was created and generously donated to the Foundation by BC artist, the late Sveva Caetani. Through these paintings the artist recounted her past, her Italian origin, and her experiences in human nature.

#### ***Human Images***

After closing at Edmonton's McMullen Gallery on April 28, this exhibition travelled to Calgary to be part of Visual Arts Week. The 46 works, selected from a humanistic point of view, follow the tradition of western art in which the human presence and its subjective interpretation by the artist is of particular importance. The show was curated by art historian Marytka Kosinski and was initially sponsored by the Friends of the University Hospitals, Edmonton.

## Provincial Travelling Exhibition Program

This fiscal period marked the seventh year of operation for this Foundation sponsored program which is implemented by:

The Edmonton Art Gallery  
Muttart Art Gallery, Calgary  
The Prairie Art Gallery, Grande Prairie  
Southern Alberta Art Gallery, Lethbridge

The Program, which circulates exhibits to schools, libraries and other public community centres, reached an estimated audience of 400,000 children, youth and adults in 1993/94. The exhibits are often incorporated into the cultural activities of communities throughout the province. The artworks, borrowed from a variety of private and public collections, including the Foundation's, are complemented by printed didactic materials. The Edmonton Art Gallery, the overall coordinating institution, has begun work on a pilot project which it hopes will address the different needs of venues by making educational packages of slides/videos available to the borrowers.

A total of 48 exhibitions toured major cities and small centres in Alberta:

- Region I (Peace Region & Northern Alberta) -  
15 exhibitions to 30 venues
- Region II (Edmonton & North Eastern Alberta)  
- 24 exhibitions to 38 venues
- Region III (Calgary & Central Alberta) - 17  
exhibitions to 36 venues
- Region IV (Lethbridge, Medicine Hat &  
Southern Alberta) - 14 exhibitions to 17  
venues

The repeat bookings by venues, the increase in attendance from year to year and the growing interest from new audience groups attest to the popularity of the Travelling Exhibition Program.

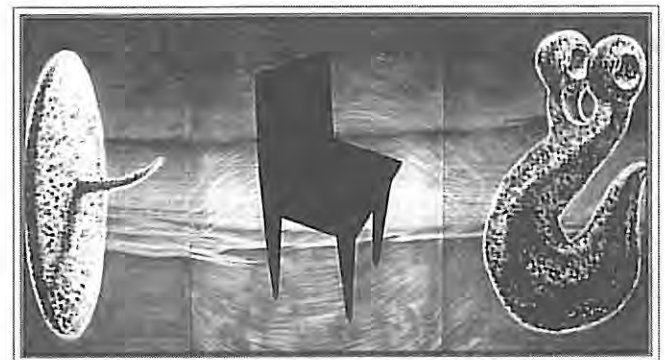
## Art Loans

The Foundation art collection continues to receive exposure through the Art Loan Program. Numerous client groups from government offices to non-profit organizations benefit from the program. The works, lent free of charge, enhance public environments and increase the public's appreciation for Alberta art. Major public galleries across the country utilize the collection as well, for exhibition purposes.

Some 2,593 artworks were displayed in 262 sites under the 1993/94 program (Appendix II).

## Promotion & Education

### "Investing In Art" Television Series

Series III of Investing In Art was completed in February, 1994. Joining the artists in the first and second series are: Sylvain Voyer, Derek Besant, Jane Kidd, Robert Guest, Alexandra Haeseker and Lyndal Osborne. Leslie Nielsen, the narrator for the other two series, once again accepted this task with his usual flare.

CBC National, ACCESS Television, CITV (Edmonton), PBS(Spokane), Superchannel, Calgary Cable North and Rogers Cable continued to broadcast all three series. Copies of the videos have also been distributed to schools at cost. The series promotes Alberta art and provides valuable information to the general public as well as teachers and educators. In addition, the film footage of the series becomes important archival documentation of major artists of this province.

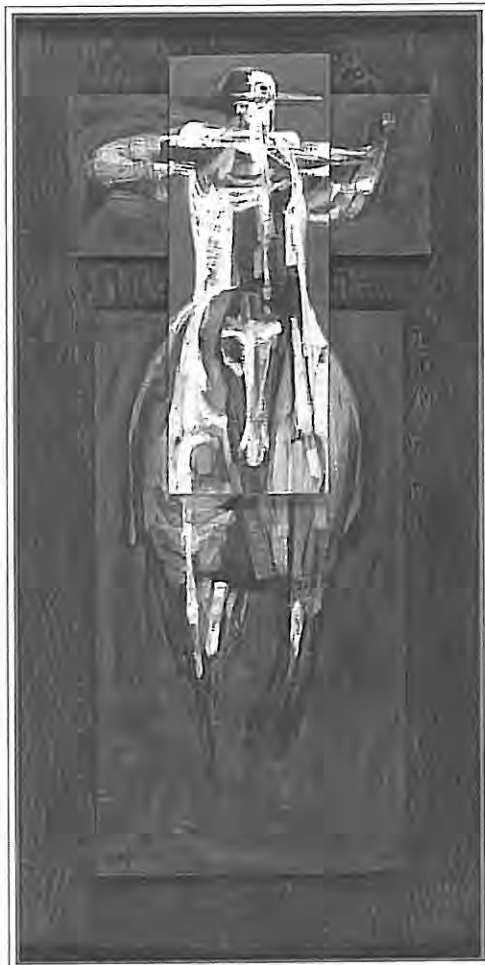

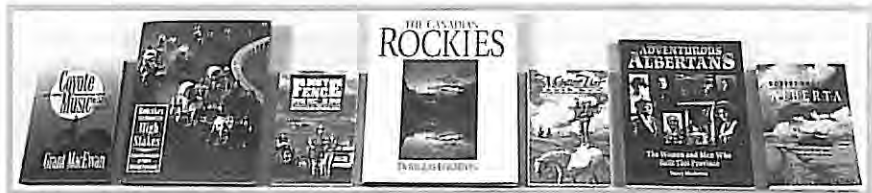

Note 1 Authority

The Alberta Foundation for the Arts operates under the authority of the Alberta Foundation for the Arts Act, Chapter A-21.5, Statutes of Alberta 1991.

The purposes of the Foundation are

- to support and contribute to the development of and to promote the arts in Alberta;
- to provide persons and organizations with the opportunity to participate in the arts in Alberta;
- to foster and promote the enjoyment of works of art by Alberta artists;
- to collect, preserve and display works of art by Alberta artists; and
- to encourage artists resident in Alberta in their work.

Note 2 Significant Accounting Policies and Reporting Practices

General

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles except that artworks are charged to operations when purchased. Notwithstanding this policy, the balance sheet also shows, for information purposes, the cumulative cost of artworks owned with a corresponding credit to equity in artworks.

Capital Assets

Cost of capital assets includes the net book value, which approximates fair market value, of capital assets assumed by the Alberta Foundation for the Arts on September 1, 1991 from The Alberta Foundation for the Performing Arts, The Alberta Foundation for the Literary Arts and The Alberta Art Foundation.

Grants

Grants are recorded as expenditure when authorized by the Board and when eligibility conditions for the grants have been satisfied.

Artworks

Purchased artworks are recorded at cost. Donated artworks are recorded at appraised values at the date of acquisition. Appraisals are performed by Foundation personnel or by a professional appraiser selected by the Foundation.

Investments

Investments are recorded at cost or amortized cost, where applicable. Amortization of premium or discount is calculated on a straight-line basis from acquisition date to maturity date.

Amortization of Capital Assets

Amortization is recorded using the straight-line method at the following rates:

Note 3 Administration Costs

Certain salary, accommodation and other overhead costs incurred in the administration of the Foundation have not been included in the Foundation's expenses. These costs are recorded by the General Revenue Fund of the Province of Alberta.

## Note 4 Cash

Cash consists of deposits in the Consolidated Cash Investment Trust Fund of the Province of Alberta. The Foundation earns interest on the daily cash balance at the average rate of interest earned by the Consolidated Cash Investment Trust Fund.

## Note 5 Long-term Deposits

Long-term deposits consist of guaranteed investment certificates issued by financial institutions and life insurance companies. The deposits can be realized only on maturity.

The restricted portion of the reserve is not available to the Foundation for use in its operations unless written approval is granted by the Minister of Community Development. The interest earned on the reserve amount is reported as operating revenue.

## Note 9 Budget

The original 1993-94 budget was approved by the Members of the Foundation on May 7, 1993. The original budget was adjusted by an increase in the contribution from the Lottery Fund of \$350,000 and increases in expenditures for the summer schools program of \$251,600 and for art promotion of \$100,000. The increases in expenditure were requested by the Minister of Community Development and approved by the Board on October 6, 1993. The increased contribution from the Lottery Fund was approved by the Deputy Premier to allow the Foundation to fund ethno-cultural arts groups.

Note 10 Salaries, Honoraria and Benefits

Note 12 Commitments

At March 31, 1994, the Foundation had commitments for grants approved but not disbursed, pending fulfilment of eligibility conditions, amounting to \$836,227.

Note 13 Comparative Figures

The 1993 figures have been reclassified where necessary to conform to 1994 presentation.

Note 14 Approval of Financial Statements

These financial statements have been approved by management and by the Chairman of the Foundation.
