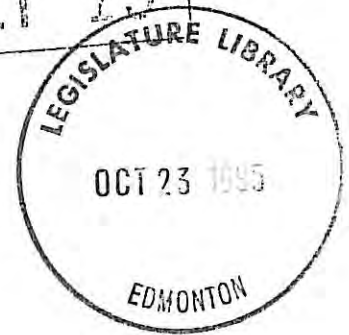

CHAIRMAN'S REMARKS

On behalf of the Board of Directors of the Alberta Foundation for the Arts, I am pleased to report on the Foundation's programs, activities and achievements for the period April 1, 1994 to March 31, 1995.

During that time the Foundation awarded \$19,960,460 in grants to artists and organizations. If we count those who attended just some of the art events and activities partially supported by these grants, we reach an estimated 5.3 million people. We are also particularly proud of our contribution to the many artists and groups who received support and went on to win national and international recognition. These include Decidedly Jazz Danceworks who toured Japan and Sun.Ergos who toured Croatia. Lesley Roberts and Marion Hoover, as members of the St. Lawrence Quartet, toured Europe, Mexico and the U.S.A. and were invited to play the White House for the Emperor of Japan.

In the visual arts, Sima Khorrani was one of nine photographers featured in a major exhibition at the Canadian Museum of Contemporary Photography in Ottawa. Wayne Traudt's film "Movement of the Body (1st Movement 'The Gesture')" won an animation award in Portugal, as well as being screened at Cannes Film Festival and shortlisted for the Academy Awards. In the literary area, Robert Hilles won the Governor General's Award for Poetry, Red Deer College Press published *Josepha*, the winner for children's book illustration, and the Award for fiction was won by Rudy Wiebe, a former member of the board of the Alberta Foundation for the Literary Arts.

Goals and Objectives

The mission of the Alberta Foundation for the Arts is a broad one: to assist all Albertans to participate fully in the cultural life of the province. Since the arts and cultural industries make a major economic, spiritual, and social contribution to the well-being of Albertans, the Foundation is a key player in "the Alberta Advantage."

Our mission is realized through the implementation of the following long term objectives:

- Support and contribute to the development of the literary, performing, visual and media arts in Alberta
- Provide both individuals and organizations with opportunities to participate in the arts in Alberta
- Promote the enjoyment of works of art by Alberta artists
- Oversee the collection, preservation and display of works of art by Alberta artists

- Encourage artists living in Alberta in their work.

In response to the government's philosophical shift from "rowing" to "steering" and to its goals of balanced budget, streamlining, public and client group consultation and the creation of an environment for economic growth and new job creation, the Foundation is working to:

- Maintain a balanced budget and reduce its administration budget by 20%
- Work with Community Development, Arts and Cultural Industries Branch, to streamline delivery of core programs
- Consult client groups and review programs to improve efficiency and equitability
- Encourage arts organizations to be more self-reliant by forming partnerships and alliances to share resources and reduce administrative and program delivery costs.

The needs expressed in "Let's Talk Culture," a series of regional meetings with the artistic communities in the province, remain our concern. The priorities identified in that series, *youth, individual artists, rural Alberta, economic and tourism development*, continue to assist us in the review of existing programs and the design of pilot projects.

Achievements

Goals and objectives were met in 1994/95 in various ways.

- The Foundation completed five regional focus-group meetings dealing with its art collection. Representatives of the Board and Department met with the visual arts communities in Grande Prairie, Edmonton, Calgary, Red Deer and Lethbridge on the art collection policies. The continuation of the Foundation art acquisition and maintenance programs was identified by participants as important to sustaining the collection as part of Alberta's cultural heritage. These consultations also led to the more extensive involvement of art professionals in art purchases.
- In partnership with the Kahanoff Foundation of Calgary, we established the Alberta Performing Arts Stabilization Fund (APASF), to provide financial assistance to major performing arts organizations to improve administrative and management performance.
- To pursue further the priorities identified in the "Let's Talk Culture" public meetings, we refined our program delivery and created the Rural Alberta Project to encourage

and assist rural communities to share cultural resources.

- A computerized Grant Management Information System was put into full operation, improving accuracy and efficiency and ensuring timely program delivery.
- The Foundation maintained the level of grant programs and reduced administrative costs. It surpassed the budget reduction goal for administration with a 23.7% reduction from the 1993/1994 budget.
- The Foundation also expanded the Artists In Schools Residency Program to include all art disciplines for the benefit of our youth.

We developed a series of partnerships with:

- Economic Development to promote Alberta festivals
- Regional colleges for summer schools: Lakeland College for Artstrek, the University of Alberta for Dramawork, Red Deer College for Series, SummerWrite and SummerScape, Augustana College for MusiCamrose
- The Alberta Heritage Scholarship Trust Fund to provide financial assistance to Albertans who wish to further their education in the arts
- Alberta Sport Council to fund the cultural components of summer games.

In the area of art acquisition and exposure, the Foundation also had an active and successful year. We acquired 297 artworks by 232 artists for the Foundation art collection as part of the artistic legacy of Alberta. Through the art loan program, we enhanced public spaces and provided artworks to public galleries, loaning 2,260 pieces to 241 venues. We also promoted the collection through seven exhibitions in Edmonton, Calgary, Wetaskiwin and Grande Prairie. The Foundation continued to support the Provincial Travelling Exhibition Program which, through the implementation by four public galleries, staged 50 exhibits for an estimated audience of 361,500 in Alberta.

Acknowledgements

The Foundation acknowledges with deep gratitude the contribution from Dr. Francis Winspear of \$500,000 for the enhancement and development of opera in Edmonton. The Foundation's art collection was enriched by the gifts of artworks by Jacques Rioux from the artist, by Helen Mackie from James Mackie, and by Graham Peacock from Wendy Rollins and Graham Peacock.


The Foundation is fortunate to receive continued support from the artistic community, the interested public and the government of Alberta. The Foundation also appreciates the

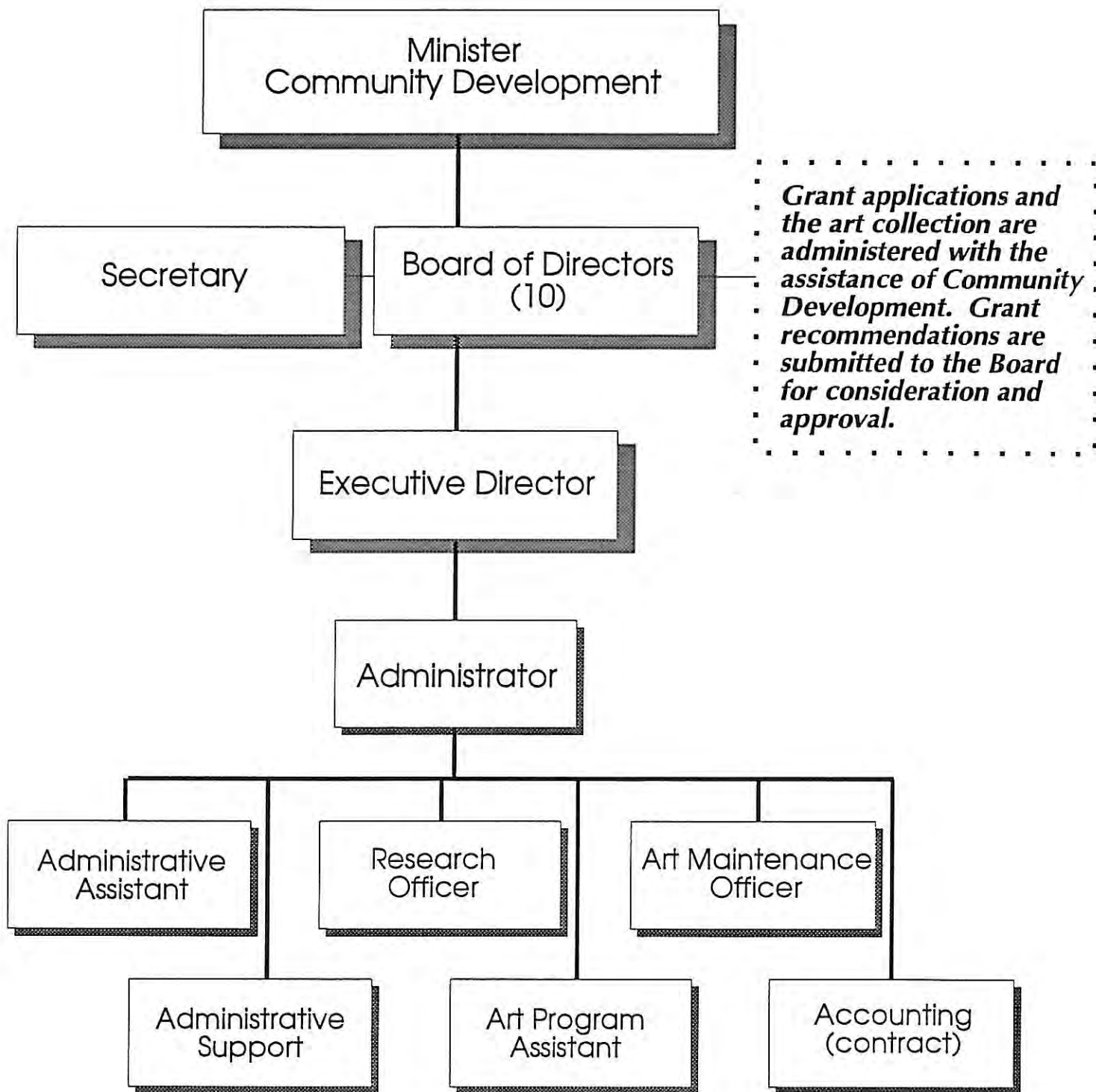

NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS
MARCH 31, 1995

Note 1 Authority and Purpose

The Alberta Foundation for the Arts (the "Foundation") operates under the authority of the Alberta Foundation for the Arts Act, Chapter A-21.5, Statutes of Alberta 1991.

The purposes of the Foundation are:

- to support and contribute to the development of and to promote the arts in Alberta;
- to provide persons and organizations with the opportunity to participate in the arts in Alberta;
- to foster and promote the enjoyment of works of art by Alberta artists;
- to collect, preserve and display works of art by Alberta artists; and
- to encourage artists resident in Alberta in their work.

Note 2 Significant Accounting Policies and Reporting Practices

Short-term Investments

Short-term investments are recorded at the lower of cost and market value.

Investments

Investments are recorded at cost or amortized cost, where applicable. Amortization of premium or discount is calculated on a straight-line basis from acquisition date to maturity date. Where there has been a loss in the value of an investment that is other than a temporary decline, the investment is written down to recognize the loss.

Capital Assets

Capital assets are recorded at cost less accumulated amortization. Amortization is provided over the estimated useful lives of the capital assets on a straight-line basis using the following annual rates:

Office furniture and equipment	15 %
Computer equipment	25 %

Artworks

Purchased artworks are recorded at cost. Donated artworks are recorded as direct increases in equity in artworks at appraised values at the date of acquisition.

Expenditure

Grants are recorded as expenditure when authorized by the Board and when eligibility conditions for the grants have been satisfied.

Note 3 Change in Accounting Policy

The Foundation has changed its accounting policy for recording purchases of artworks. Previously, purchases of artworks were charged to operations as expenditure in the year of acquisition.

Under the new policy, purchased artworks are not expensed but are recorded as a transfer to equity in artworks. This change in accounting policy has been applied retroactively, and accordingly the 1994 figures have been restated. The effect of this change is a decrease in expenditure and in the deficiency of revenue over expenditure for the year of \$317,075 (1994 \$270,365). This change has had no effect on the balance sheet.

Note 4 Administration Costs

Certain salary costs, estimated to be approximately \$435,000, accommodation and other overhead costs incurred in the administration of the Foundation have not been included in the Foundation's expenditure. These costs are incurred and recorded by the General Revenue Fund of the Province of Alberta.

Note 5 Cash

Cash consists of deposits in the Consolidated Cash Investment Trust Fund of the Province of Alberta. The Foundation earns interest on the daily cash balance at the average rate of interest earned by the Consolidated Cash Investment Trust Fund.

Note 8 Grant Payable to the Alberta Sport, Recreation, Parks and Wildlife Foundation

The \$80,500 payable to the Alberta Sport, Recreation, Parks and Wildlife Foundation is for a grant for staging a cultural component at the Alberta Games.

Note 9 Long-term Grant Payable

The Foundation has signed an agreement to give \$2,500,000 over a period of three to five years to the Alberta Performing Arts Stabilization Fund, a corporation that will provide grants and technical and management assistance to performing arts organizations in Alberta. The amount to be paid in 1995-96 has been recorded as a current liability.

Note 10 General Reserve

The general reserve has been established by appropriations from the fund balance to provide a long-term autonomous source of future funding.

The reserve is not available to the Foundation for use in its operations unless written approval is received from the Minister of Community Development. Interest earned on the reserve amount is reported as operating revenue.

Note 11 Budget

Note 12 Operating Assistance Grants

Operating assistance grants are mainly paid to organizations to assist them in meeting a portion of their operating expenditure. The Foundation's grants enable organizations to carry out their mandates and to attract other funding. The grants have been paid to organizations in the following major groupings:
